Children with poorly controlled asthma often land in the emergency room with an oxygen mask on the face. At the Morgridge Academy, on the National Jewish Health main Denver campus, children with severe asthma and other chronic diseases receive medical care and education that helps them manage their disease. As a result, they stay out of the hospital and in the classroom, pushing beyond medical and academic boundaries that had limited their life choices in the past.

MORGRIDGE ACADEMY

In spring 2013, the Morgridge Family Foundation pledged \$15 million to National Jewish Health. In honor of that gift, National Jewish Health renamed its free school for chronically ill children the Morgridge Academy. Every year, this school serves 90 chronically ill children, kindergarten through 8th grade, helping them achieve in academics as well as helping the children and their families learn to manage their illness. The Morgridge Academy is the only free school of its kind in the nation on a medical campus.

Based on our experience helping students at the Morgridge Academy manage their severe asthma, we have pushed beyond our campus to help hundreds of children in Denver public schools better manage their asthma. Now, we are extending that model of asthma care to schools across the nation.

In scientific research, cutting-edge microscopes allow our scientists to peer beyond the surface of cells, into living organs, where they can watch the complex and vital dynamics of cell movement and interactions that cannot be seen in cell cultures or tissue slices on glass slides.

Patients with cystic fibrosis, who used to die before school age, now live well past childhood into their 40s, 50s and beyond. With new advances in medications and diagnostic tools, many developed at National Jewish Health, those survival boundaries will continue to be surpassed.

National Jewish Health also is helping lung cancer patients live longer with improved screening for early stage disease, ultra-low-radiation imaging and rigorous follow-up, to make sure suspicious lung nodules are caught before they become deadly cancers.

In recent years, we have extended our patient care beyond our campus to 22 sites across Colorado. At several of those sites, we have partnered with other hospitals and health care facilities. As we look to the future and the rapidly changing landscape of health care in America, we expect to continue providing differentiated care that brings together research and clinical expertise for patients and their families searching for answers in Colorado and worldwide.

Looking beyond boundaries is our philosophy here at National Jewish Health. Thanks to the generous support of our donors, we can fulfill that philosophy. As we extend our knowledge, our care and our partners, we will continue making the advances that improve patients' lives today and tomorrow.

BEYOND THE FRONT DOOR



Asthma under control, Merlyn Paine once again can venture out into the world near her Carson City, Nev., home and beyond.

Three years ago Merlyn Paine rarely left her home in Nevada.

She could no longer work, didn't visit friends and ventured to the grocery store only late at night when she felt it was safe. Merlyn suffered from severe asthma that caused immediate breathing problems when she was exposed to strong scents such as perfumes and soaps.

Merlyn found National Jewish Health interventional pulmonologist Ali Musani, MD, one of the world's leading practitioners of a new procedure called bronchial thermoplasty. Bronchial thermoplasty uses heat to reduce the size of muscles surrounding the airways, which constrict during an asthma attack. It is an important new option for severe asthmatics who do not respond to medications. Studies show that it reduces asthma attacks, emergency room visits and medication use.

Since having bronchial thermoplasty, Merlyn has returned to work, resumed an active social life and traveled throughout the United States for both work and pleasure.



Beyond the Clinic with Asthma Care

Asthma impacts education as one of the main causes of missed school days. For several years, National Jewish Health has worked with Denver Public Schools to improve asthma care for students with the disease. The program identifies children with asthma, teaches them how to manage their disease and develops a support team to help. The program reduces school absences, frequency of asthma symptoms and urgent care visits to the doctor. Recently, the National Jewish Health team received a grant to take this successful program to other cities. They are now working with schools in Hartford, Conn., and expect to expand to other cities in coming years.

Personalized Approach Helps Treat Severe Asthma

In spite of better medications and treatment guidelines, up to half of asthma patients continue to suffer from poorly controlled disease; they wake up at night, make urgent trips to the emergency room and miss work and school. National Jewish Health physicians James Good, MD, and Richard Martin, MD, have developed an individualized approach to asthma care that guides effective treatment for many of the most difficult-to-treat asthma cases, known as refractory asthma. They use a bronchoscope to actually look at the airways and to obtain tissue samples.

This approach provides much better information than relying solely on measurements of breathing capacity and has allowed the physicians to divide asthma

patients into five specific categories: those with gastroesophageal reflux, subacute bacterial infections, tissue eosinophilia (high numbers of immune cells known as eosinophils), a combination of categories and nonspecific. Each subtype suggests a specific therapeutic strategy in addition to standard therapy.

Using this personalized approach for patients with refractory asthma improves their lung function, on average, by 25 percent and asthma control by 60 percent. With their scientific publications describing the approach and new educational programs, more physicians around the country are learning how to help their most difficult-to-treat asthma patients.

ELL'S SURFACE

Immunologists Rachel Friedman, PhD, and Jordan Jacobelli, PhD, compare multi-photon microscopy to watching people interact with each other in dynamic social situations.

Traditional microscopy is more like watching a person in solitary confinement. The multi-photon microscope uses highly focused infrared laser light to see deeper into an object, allowing Friedman and Jacobelli to examine intact living tissue rather than cells in culture or thin slices of dead tissue.

"We can see into the organ, how cells interact and where they go," said Friedman. Repeated photographs at many depths allow Friedman and Jacobelli to make three-dimensional movies of these cellular interactions.

Friedman uses the cutting-edge technology to learn how islet cells in the pancreas are destroyed in diabetes. Jacobelli is studying how rogue T cells cross the blood-brain barrier and attack the nervous system in multiple sclerosis. They also work with other researchers at National Jewish Health, most recently helping Philippa Marrack, PhD, learn how adjuvants make vaccines more effective.

Research Identifies Risk Factors for NTM

When Essie Keyser traveled from Maryland to spend a week at National Jewish Health, where she received a diagnosis and treatment for her infection with nontuberculous mycobacteria (NTM), she noticed an odd thing about her fellow patients. So many of them seemed to be tall, slender women in their 50s and 60s. Recent research by pulmonologist Ed Chan, MD, has borne out Essie's casual observation; NTM patients are, on average, 2 inches taller and 35 pounds lighter than the average American woman of the same age. The research also identified immune abnormalities in these women, which could help explain why this omnipresent organism infects them more often, and suggests therapeutic strategies for fighting this increasingly common disease.

National Jewish Health has unparalleled expertise in NTM. Its physicians see more patients than any other center in the world. Researchers and physicians at the National Jewish Health NTM Center of Excellence are developing DNA tests to enhance identification of NTM species, as well as tests to identify antibiotic-resistant strains and determine the most effective combinations of antibiotics to treat the disease.



Finding Answers in Electronic Health Records

Hospitals and medical offices are seeking to save money while becoming more efficient by replacing paper files with electronic medical records.

At National Jewish Health, the massive amount of clinical, radiological and biological information in those medical records is turning out to be very important to our research as well. Using anonymized electronic health records as a research tool, National Jewish Health researchers have found a new drug for autoimmune lung disease, discovered immune abnormalities in patients with nontuberculous mycobacterial infections, and identified promising candidates for trials of new cancer drugs.

National Jewish Health has pushed this strategy a step further by integrating electronic health records with tissue samples taken from thousands of patients who agreed to participate in research. That allows researchers not only to look for patterns in data already collected but also to gather additional information from the biological samples as new questions arise.

BEYOND TRADITIONAL ANSWERS



Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is the third-leading cause of death in the U.S. and a major source of chronic disability — affecting more than 20 million Americans.

National Jewish Health and Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston are together leading COPDGene®, an intensive study of 10,000 past and current smokers with and without the disease. By analyzing genomes, blood samples, CT scans, medical histories and the long-term course of participants' disease, researchers hope to understand how the disease differs from person to person, as well as why some smokers get COPD and others do not, and to identify targeted, personalized and effective new therapies.

Five years after the study began, researchers have gathered mountains of data from all 10,000 participants and are beginning to understand the complex relationships that distinguish each individual's disease. In fiscal year 2013, COPDGene received a second five-year, \$36 million grant from the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute, which will allow the research team to continue teasing out the complex interplay of genes and environment that cause disease in COPD patients.

Patients Help Guide Research

It seems obvious that patients with a disease would be in a good position to help guide research to treat it. Historically, however, patients have had very little voice in the direction of medical research — until now. At National Jewish Health, pulmonologist Jeffrey Swigris, DO, MS, has created the Participation Program for Pulmonary Fibrosis, inviting pulmonary fibrosis patients to help guide research by providing insights into life with the disease and the issues they care about most

and to participate in research. The first study seeks to determine whether and how supplemental oxygen helps patients with pulmonary fibrosis. Does oxygen really make patients feel better? Or is any potential benefit outweighed by the drawbacks of being “tied” to an oxygen tank? There are no real data that address those questions; oxygen is just something doctors always prescribe. No one has asked patients what they think, until now.

Cystic Fibrosis Beyond Childhood

In the 1950s, there were no adults with cystic fibrosis (CF); patients rarely survived long enough to attend elementary school. Today, more than half are older than 18, and many live well into their 40s, 50s and 60s. National Jewish Health has been an integral part of this story, one of the most exciting in pulmonary medicine. The Adult CF program, led by Jerry Nick, MD, has improved treatment, evaluated new medications and cared for an increasingly large population of adult cystic fibrosis patients from around the country. It is the largest such program in the nation.

In 2012, thanks in part to research done at National Jewish Health, the first medication to correct the malfunctioning chloride channel that causes the disease was approved for a small subset of patients with a specific genetic mutation. Dr. Nick and his colleagues are now conducting a unique trial to test whether the medication works for a wider population of patients. They also are evaluating a combination of medications designed to treat 70 percent of patients with the most common mutation. Pulmonologist Milene Saavedra, MD, recently described a genetic test that helps guide treatment for bacterial infections, the primary cause of sickness and death in CF patients. The test has garnered two patents and is close to being commercially available.

BEYOND THE FINISH LINE

When Candace Wollert started running for the University of Wyoming track team, she developed a deep, hacking cough.

Her cough went away only when she stopped running. Her chest burned and felt raw. Doctors diagnosed exercise-induced asthma. By her junior year, Candace was taking five different asthma medications but she still struggled to run, and became ill weekly during hard practices.

Candace came to National Jewish Health, where she saw Tod Olin, MD, a pulmonologist who specializes in exercise medicine. Dr. Olin has developed a sophisticated test called continuous laryngoscopy, which for the first time allows doctors to watch the vocal cords during exercise. Since Candace's symptoms appeared only when she ran, and resolved within seconds after she stopped, this new test was crucial to understanding her problem.

That test helped deliver a new diagnosis for Candace: vocal cord dysfunction (VCD). During periods of intense exercise, her vocal cords nearly closed, leaving her struggling to get air through a small opening. A speech therapist at National Jewish Health taught Candace techniques to keep her vocal cords open. She no longer takes asthma medications except for an inhaler she uses only occasionally.

National Jewish Health physicians advise parents when to introduce potentially allergenic foods into their children's diets.

Food Allergy Recommendations Evolve

As food allergies grow increasingly common, especially among children, attention has turned to strategies for preventing them. In 2012, the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology asked pediatric allergist David Fleischer, MD, to lead a team of food allergy experts to develop recommendations for prevention of food allergies through nutritional intervention.

Their report, published in 2013 in the *Journal of Allergy & Clinical Immunology: In Practice*, represented a significant change from previous recommendations. Citing evidence that has accumulated at National Jewish Health and other research institutions around the nation, Dr. Fleischer and his colleagues

recommended that potentially allergenic foods, such as milk, egg, soy, peanuts and fish, be introduced into infants' diets early, beginning at four to six months. Previous recommendations have advised waiting until 2 to 3 years of age for some of these highly allergenic foods. Accumulating evidence, however, suggests it is better to introduce these foods earlier, while the immune system is still in its early stages of development and more likely to develop tolerance to those foods. Those recommendations come with a caveat to consult an allergist if a child has difficult-to-treat eczema or a known food allergy.

Beyond the Best in Lung Function

When National Jewish Health physicians want to know what is going on with their patients' lungs, they send them to the Pulmonary Physiology Unit (PPU), one of the world's largest, most advanced and original laboratories for evaluating lung function. Whether it is measuring air flow into and out of the lungs, oxygen diffusion from the lungs into the bloodstream, inflammation, or distinguishing the lungs from the heart as a source of breathlessness, the combination of expert technicians and state-of-the-art equipment provides unparalleled insight into the vital elements of breathing.

In 2013, the PPU received a major equipment upgrade, further enhancing capabilities to conduct tests both common and rare. Among the rare tests performed at National Jewish Health is the environmental chamber, where patients' lung function is measured as they are exposed to potential allergens or irritants ranging from perfume to cigarette smoke. Another test determines just how strongly a person deprived of air works to breathe; surprisingly, some people don't sense they are short of oxygen and don't respond adequately.

Approximately 90 percent of patients who come to the hospital receive a test in the PPU. The PPU also plays a critical role in advancing research at National Jewish Health, collaborating with faculty on over 30 projects at any given time.



SURVIVING BEYOND FIVE YEARS

Rachel Carrington was lucky.

A CT scan for digestive problems revealed a nodule on her lung, which brought her to Ali Musani, MD, and James Jett, MD, at National Jewish Health. After an extensive work-up, they recommended surgery to remove the nodule, which turned out to be an especially aggressive form of lung cancer. Today, two years after completing chemotherapy, she is cancer-free and has an excellent prognosis.

Five-year survival for all lung cancer patients has remained stubbornly low, around 15 percent. The most promising strategy for improving lung cancer survival is early detection. Dr. Jett contributed to a landmark study demonstrating that annual CT screening of high-risk patients could reduce lung cancer deaths by 20 percent.

National Jewish Health is working hard to push that number higher and take the luck out of lung cancer detection and survival. Clinical trials are testing better ways to detect early stage lung cancer with low-dose radiation CT scans and biomarkers. Physicians in the Lung Nodule Clinic are able to biopsy small nodules with advanced navigational tools that help guide bronchoscopes to previously inaccessible nodules.




Elizabeth Kern, MD, leads the effort for timely, accurate diagnoses of lung nodules.

Life Saving Follow-Up

The devil is in the details. While lung cancer screening of high-risk patients promises to save thousands of lives in the coming years, it will depend on consistent and timely follow-up once a suspicious nodule is detected. The vast majority of nodules detected on screening are benign. Without systematic follow-up, however, the relatively few cancerous ones are likely to slip through the cracks and become deadly before they are detected. Reports indicate that close to 40 percent of patients fail to get follow-up scans in a timely manner.

Elizabeth Kern, MD, and her colleagues have developed a lung nodule registry that allows radiologists to use a carefully constructed staging and recommendation system to help deliver on the promise of lung cancer screening. They developed a structured language for radiologists, which includes specific descriptions of nodules and recommendations for follow-up for those at risk. Those reports can be read by computers, which automatically create letters to notify physicians and patients and even prompt phone calls to make sure patients receive follow-up scans. With such a rigorous, standardized and automated approach, more patients will get the scans that can save their lives.

Back to the Future with Ultra-Low-Dose Imaging

To realize the promise of CT screening to save the lives of patients with lung cancer, many patients will have to receive multiple CT scans over several years. Unfortunately, that practice increases the chances of exposure to excess radiation. Radiologist Joyce Schroeder, MD, is working with Siemens Healthcare on a new method for achieving effective CT scans with ultra-low doses of radiation for the detection of subtle pulmonary nodules.

CT scans require massive amounts of computer processing to turn raw data from hundreds of sensors and individual images into a single three-dimensional image of the lungs. Thanks to more powerful computers

and less expensive memory, Dr. Schroeder and Siemens are experimenting with a processing method originally designed when CT scanning was first invented, but then abandoned because it took hours to process each image. It holds promise of using ultra-low levels of radiation while delivering images clear enough to detect the small, fuzzy nodules that need to be followed.

Beyond Boundaries

Financial Report


National Jewish Health enjoyed especially strong support from our donors this year. Contributions increased more than \$8 million over the prior year. In fact, National Jewish Health raised over \$30 million in 2013, more than any year in our 114-year history.

The federal budget issues created challenges for hospitals nationwide, and National Jewish Health was no exception. Federal sequestration resulted in across-the-board funding cuts in governmental programs such as Medicare. Additionally, Medicare's "gap fill" method of determining rates for molecular laboratory testing resulted in no payment for these tests from January through October. In spite of these challenges, National Jewish Health clinical programs continued to grow. Patient visits increased almost 5 percent year over year. As a result of the decreases in reimbursement, however, net patient service revenue remained flat.

Federal budget pressures continue to change the face of research around the country. With the budget cuts at the National Institutes of Health, research grant funding fell 11 percent in fiscal year 2013. National Jewish Health continued to refine its research to meet the challenges of this new funding environment, focusing on close collaborations between basic and clinical scientists, efficiencies of the research support infrastructure and pursuit of new funding sources. The success of these efforts was evidenced by a more than 12 percent increase in non-federal grant revenues and large grant awards received from the Colorado Health Foundation and the Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute.

National Jewish Health maintains a well-diversified investment portfolio. In spite of turbulent markets in the last months of the fiscal year, we recorded close to \$11 million of investment returns. Overall, revenues increased close to 7 percent over 2012. Due to tight expense controls, total expenses increased only 1 percent year over year.

National Jewish Health continues to focus on our *10-Year Strategic Plan: The Decade of Innovation*. Our personalized approach to coordinated patient care and the integration of research in our clinical programs position us well for success in the continually changing health care environment. We continue to investigate opportunities to enhance our programs while maintaining our financial strength. Toward that end, we executed two letters of intent to partner with others to expand our clinical programs. Both of these opportunities preserve our independence and our mission. We are currently evaluating these opportunities and will continue to explore others during the coming year.








Demand for National Jewish Health expertise continues to grow.




RESEARCH GRANT REVENUE (millions)


